

Getting to the station and buying tickets

Melksham Station is situated just off the Bath Road to the north of the town. It's an easy walk from the town centre, and there are cycle racks and free parking there.

There is no ticket office nor ticket machine at Melksham station, which means you can get on the train without a ticket and buy one from the train manager.

There are sometimes low cost advance fares available online. These tie you to a particular train, and you must have the tickets delivered by post or collect them from a station with a ticket machine before you travel.

A wide range of tickets and fares is available – please check with First Great Western for the most appropriate ticket, and for terms and conditions.
